### Exercise A

- 1. An experienced pilot flew the plane.

### Exercise B

Since passive voice doesn't require the 'doer' in the sentence, it is optional and is therefore in square brackets.

- 3. The book was written three years ago [by me].
- 4. The essays have been marked [by me].
- 5. The children were picked up from school [by Omar].
- 6. The boxes were stacked in the front room [by Jane].
